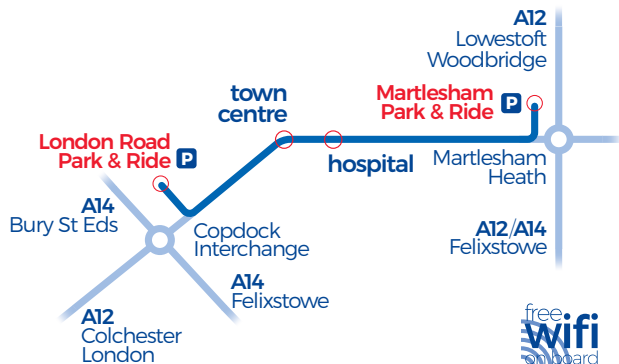
No matter why you're heading into town, parking has never been easier than with **park & ride**.

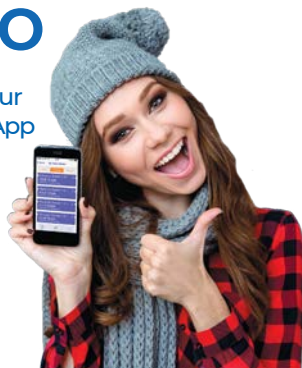

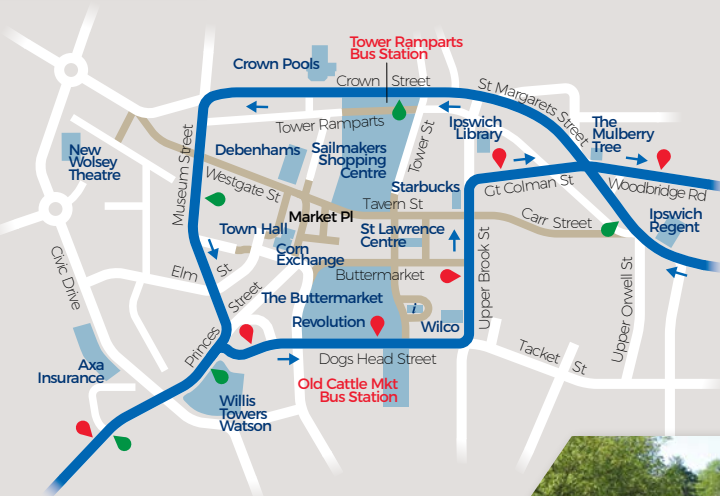
