Starting Point: Pub on the Prom, Great Yarmouth

14:30 Depart Pub on the Prom

Hop aboard the open-top **Coastal Clipper Cabriolet** from outside the Pub on the Prom at **14:30**. Buses run every 20 minutes throughout the afternoon, travelling along Great Yarmouth's famous Golden Mile before heading north through Caister-on-Sea, Scratby and on to Hemsby.

Take a seat on the top deck and enjoy panoramic views across the coastline as you leave the bustling seafront behind and travel through Norfolk's beautiful coastal villages.

15:05 – Hemsby Beach

Arrive at **Hemsby Beach**, one of Norfolk's most popular family seaside destinations.

Spend the afternoon making the most of everything Hemsby has to offer. Build sandcastles on the wide sandy beach, enjoy a game of crazy golf, browse the amusement arcades or simply relax amongst the dunes while the children let off some steam.

If you're feeling peckish, you'll find plenty of traditional seaside favourites nearby, from freshly cooked fish and chips to ice cream, doughnuts and other sweet treats.

After dinner, spend some time exploring Great Yarmouth's famous seaside attractions. Enjoy a round of crazy golf, visit one of the two historic piers, browse the amusement arcades, or take a ride on the giant wheel for spectacular views across the coastline.

As the evening draws in, make your way towards the Pleasure Beach ready for the final highlight of your day.

20:00 – Evening Illuminations

As the sun begins to set, board the **20:00 Coastal Clipper Cabriolet** opposite the Pleasure Beach for a magical evening journey along the Golden Mile.

During the summer holidays, the open-top buses continue into the evening, offering a completely different perspective of Great Yarmouth as the seafront comes alive with lights and entertainment.

From the top deck you'll enjoy spectacular views of:

- The illuminated Golden Mile
- Britannia Pier glowing against the evening sky
- Colourful amusement arcades and attractions
- Stunning coastal sunset views
- The vibrant atmosphere of Great Yarmouth after dark

The round trip takes around 30 minutes, travelling as far as Seashore Holiday Park before returning along the seafront. If you're not quite ready for the adventure to end, why not stay on board and enjoy the ride all over again?
