a whole new electric fleet	PINK LINE 11-12 By March next year we'll have 59 new double deckers and 11 new single deckers for these Network Norwich city routes. Our Roundtree Way depot is going fully electric and will use renewable electricity to charge each bus overnight.
	The powerful batteries - up to six times more powerful than those in a standard electric car - allow a bus to keep going all day.
a cleaner, greener Norwich	Each bus produces zero emissions at the tail pipe, meaning cleaner air for Norwich. The CO ₂ savings, at least 75 tonnes* per bus per year, will also help in the battle against climate change.
a quieter Norwich	Our electric buses are smooth and so quiet that at low speed a sound is made, warning of their presence.
