Starting Point: South Parade, Tenby

11:07 – Depart South Parade

Hop aboard the **Explore Tenby** open-top bus from **South Parade** at **11:07** and enjoy one of Wales' most scenic bus journeys.

As you travel towards Saundersfoot, you'll pass through New Hedges while taking in spectacular views of the Pembrokeshire coastline from the top deck. Sit back, relax and enjoy the journey before arriving in this picturesque seaside village.

11:33 – Saundersfoot

Arrive in **Saundersfoot**, a charming harbour village that perfectly blends beautiful beaches with a rich maritime history.

Spend the rest of the morning exploring the picturesque harbour, browsing independent shops and enjoying the relaxed seaside atmosphere. Families can try their hand at crabbing from the harbour walls, while those looking to stretch their legs can enjoy a walk along part of the spectacular Pembrokeshire Coast Path for even more breathtaking coastal views.

With its golden sandy beach and welcoming cafés, Saundersfoot is the perfect place to begin your Explore adventure.

13:00 – Lunch by the Harbour

When you're done exploring, enjoy lunch overlooking the sea.

Whether you're in the mood for freshly caught seafood, traditional fish and chips or a relaxed family meal, Saundersfoot has plenty of fantastic options to choose from.

14:37 – Return to Tenby

14:52 – Explore Historic Tenby

Known as the "Jewel in Pembrokeshire's Crown", Tenby is one of the country's most colourful and historic seaside towns.

Spend the afternoon wandering through its narrow medieval streets, discovering independent shops and enjoying spectacular views across Carmarthen Bay.

Make your way down to the picturesque harbour, where colourful Georgian houses overlook the water and fishing boats gently bob in the bay. If you're looking to add another adventure to your day, you could take a short boat trip across to **Caldey Island**, home to a community of Cistercian monks and an abundance of wildlife.

16:30 – Castle Hill & Castle Beach

Before finishing your day, take the short walk up to **Castle Hill** for some of the finest views in Pembrokeshire.

From here you can look out across **Castle Beach**, **St Catherine's Island**, **Tenby Harbour** and **Carmarthen Bay**, making it the perfect place to pause for a few family photographs.

Afterwards, head down to Castle Beach where children can enjoy paddling, building sandcastles or simply relaxing on the beautiful beach.

17:30 – Finish with a Bite to Eat

Round off your day with an early evening meal in Tenby.

Whether you fancy traditional fish and chips from **D. Fecci & Sons**, freshly made pizza from **Top Joe's**, or coffee and homemade cakes from **Loafley Bakery & Deli Co.**, you'll find plenty of independent eateries to end your day on a high before making your way home.
