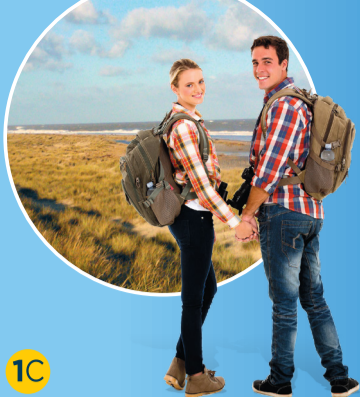

Winterton 1
Unspoilt and natural, the beach and dunes at Winterton are a great place to set out on a walk through the natural beauty of the Norfolk coast. The area is home to all sorts of wildlife including the famous seal colony just north of the beach

Hemsby 1 1A 1B 1C
Hemsby beach is great for families with soft sand, dunes, amusements and seaside cafes. You'll find ten-pin bowling, Lost World adventure golf and MB's Funhouse indoor play area with its slides, cargo nets and ball pits - great for when it's wet.

Caister-on-Sea 1 1A 1B 1C
This popular and very beautiful seaside resort is steeped in history, not least with the remains of a Roman fort built in 200AD. Caister is a great place to enjoy some of Britain's most picturesque and family-friendly coastline, with kids playparks and refreshments all along the beach front. It's also an ideal location to fly a kite.

And it's also great for walkers too! You could even walk all the way from Great Yarmouth and catch the bus back again.

Gorleston 1 1A
Set below cliff gardens, the beach is a firm favourite for lazy days in the sun. There's a large paddling pool and yacht pond, tennis courts and a trim-trail on the cliff top with views of the beach, pier and Edwardian theatre. Enjoy the amusements, the restaurants, pubs and cafés in the town.

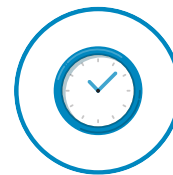
