






Make sure you are at the bus stop with time to spare.

Make sure the bus has fully stopped and make your way to the exit.


When leaving the bus, watch out for other pedestrians and traffic.

#### emergency YOU MUST...

Make your way out of the bus using the nearest EMERGENCY EXIT.

These are located to the rear and front of the bus.

#### emergency You Must...

Use the 'hammer'
located on the bus to break a window if the EMERGENCY EXITS are blocked and exit safely through it.

#### emergency You MUST...

Exit the bus and stand well clear. Follow instructions given by the driver.
